Requested a response within 24hrs.	The construction team conducted initial investigations the following morning and confirmed no concrete pouring occurred on the 12th of November. A concrete pour was scheduled for 19 Nov with the first truck arriving to site at 7:15am. However due to weather, this concrete pour did not go ahead. The team has asked if Council could confirm the above dates to investigate further. No response was received from Council.
